



Rules

- Students are expected to be ready for their lessons and classes. This means a student is expected to arrive, and warm up and stretch at least 10 to 15 minutes before a lesson or rehearsal begins. This transition period assists in one's focus and physical well-being.
- Proper dance attire including form fitting clothes and proper dance shoes are expected to be worn at every dance class. Dancers are to be ready for class at the starting time with hair done and shoes on when they walk into their classroom.
- Students arriving late are not permitted to just walk into class. Late students should ask the teacher for permission to join a class that has already started by waiting just inside of the classroom door.
- A student who comes late to class, based on the instructor's discretion, may not be permitted to take class yet will be expected to observe. This is to reduce any possible injury. Students arriving 5 minutes late for an hour class or 10 minutes late for a class more than an hour in length can expect to be told to sit and watch for that day. They may make-up the class on another day.
- Teachers should be addressed with respect. Ms. Jamie, Mr. Timothy, unless otherwise instructed by the individual teacher. This is to help the students maintain a more professional demeanor.
- No gum, food or drinks are permitted in the rehearsal studios or dressing rooms. Water is permitted.
- Students may not sit down unless instructed to do so by their teacher.
- No excessive conversations should take place during class. This can be disruptive to fellow classmates during class. We all can learn by observing others.
- Please be respectful of yourself and others. Kindness goes far. No foul language will be tolerated.

- Students under 12 years old may not leave the classroom without the teacher's permission. This is for their safety.
- Students need to call the studio at (626) 963-1300 to let their teacher know if they are going to miss class. You are expected to make up any missed classes within the semester. You may take a make-up class at your level or lower. Any other options must be discussed with the instructor. This is to keep your training moving forward. Students enrolled in our Summer Musical Program are expected to participate in the complete dance program.
- Observation is permitted from a waiting room where available or in the studio at the instructor's discretion. Please refrain from peeking through the door. This is a distraction to the teachers and students. The doors should not be blocked, as someone may trip over another child or object when leaving class.
- Parents are not allowed to run into on-going classes. If you have a concern please ask the front desk to pass a note onto the teacher and they will meet with you while on break, or after class.
- Parents, if you need to remove your child early from class, please inform the teacher prior to class. If an emergency arises, please inform the front desk, and they will quietly bring your child to you. This will reduce distraction and anxiety.
- Parents please be prompt to pick your children up at the end of class. Teachers tend to have classes back to back, and we cannot baby-sit students. If they must wait, have them prepared ahead of time with some work to keep them occupied. The studio will not stay open more than 10 minutes after the last class of the evening.
